PL/2023/06627 - 1 Brow Cottages - application restarted Change of use of land into domestic garden curtilage and erection of a detached outbuilding for use as a home office/additional accommodation

PL/2023/08166 - Hartwood House - Extension and alteration works including replacement of the former single storey extension at the rear with a new 2-storey rear extension and a single storey orangery; replacement and repositioning of garage; new greenhouse.
